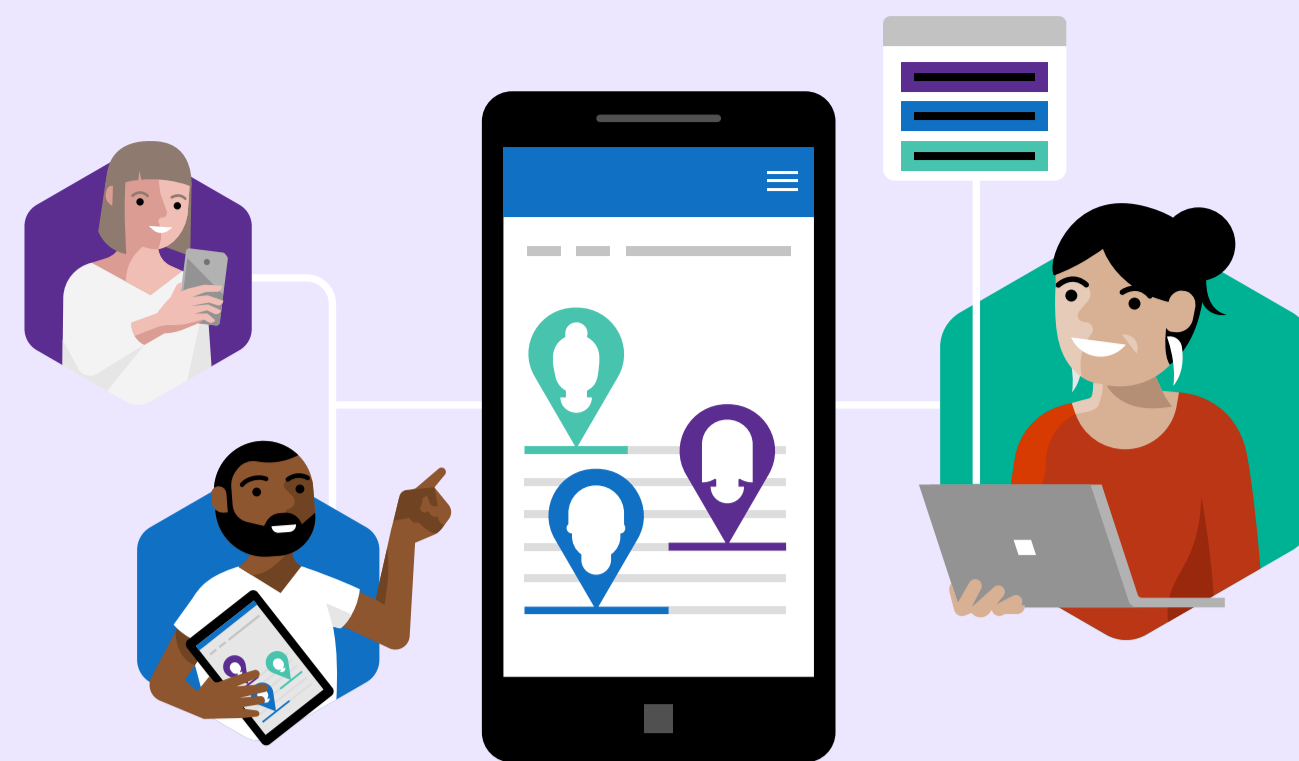


Amplify your apps with the Microsoft Teams Developer Platform



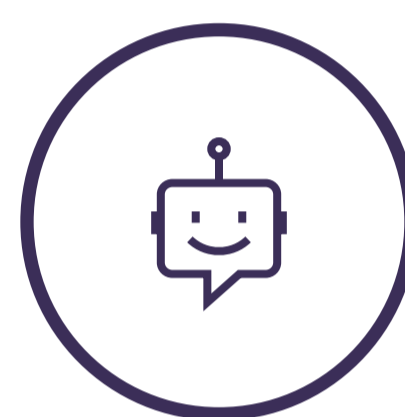
Microsoft Teams is a powerful and extensible platform that allows you to build apps with a rich set of capabilities for each your users through chat, channels, notifications, and personal workspace.

The following are just some of the capabilities you can unlock to create apps or integrate them with new or existing business processes thanks to Teams' open developer platform:



Tabs

Add rich dashboards and data visualization, collaborate on documents and note taking, manage tasks across the group, share designs through channels or private chats.



Bots

Enable kick-off workflows and provide status on them, give and receive kudos from team members, create lightweight surveys to gauge employee satisfaction, and answer natural language questions about sales and customer usage data.



Connectors

Embed useful information and rich content from external services into channels in Microsoft Teams. Also, get social media notifications, updates about pull and push requests, and news updates.



Actionable messages

Integrate rich content to your connector cards, such as embedding actions within emails or notifications to elevate user engagement and increase organizational productivity.



Compose extensions

Empower users to interact with your web service through buttons and forms in the Microsoft Teams client. Search or initiate actions in an external system from the compose message area, the command box, or directly from a message.



Activity feed

Use it to engage users via feed notifications and to display all of your colleagues' activities across the teams, channels, chats, and apps that you have access to.
