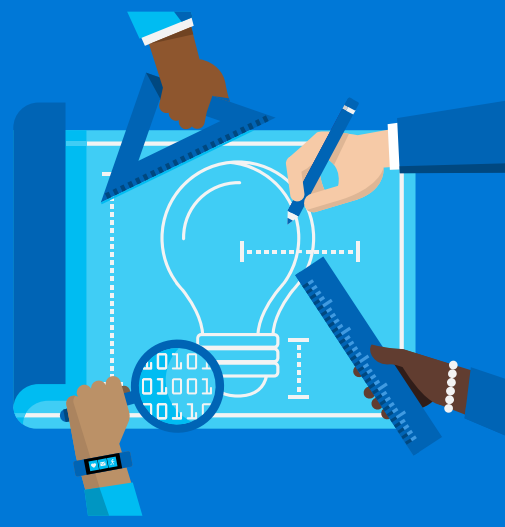

Here are 3 office design principles to fuel productivity.¹

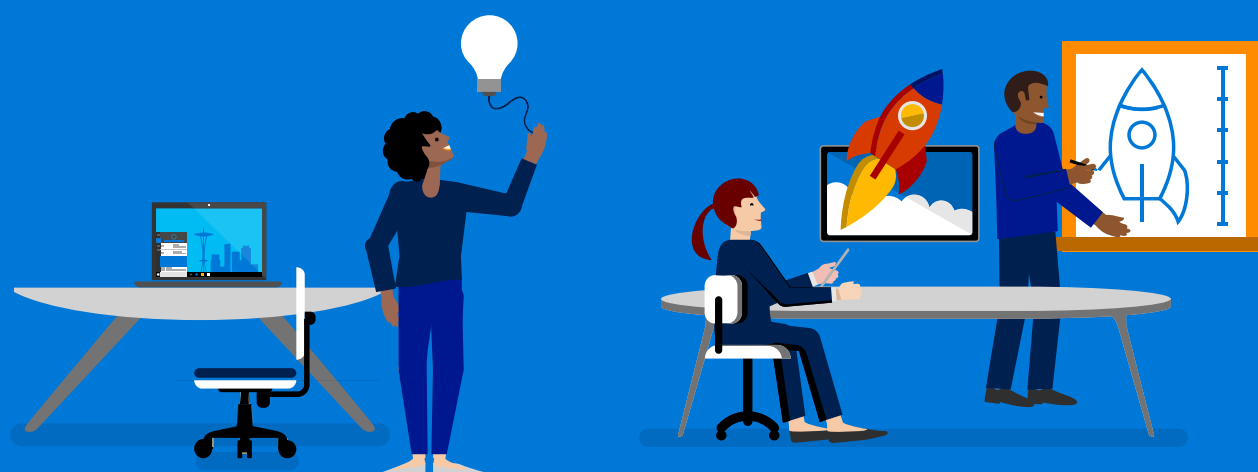


- 1 Physical**

If you have an open-concept office that’s highly connective, consider “quiet rooms” to enable deep thinking.

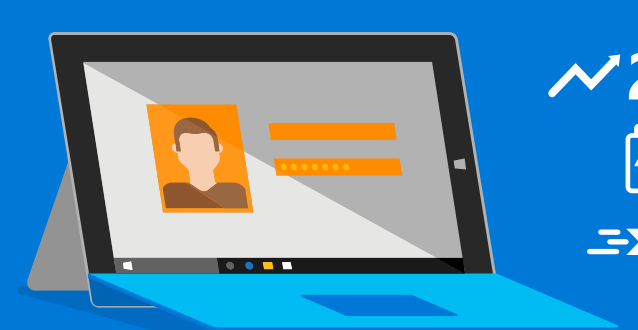
Putting off new computer purchases to save cost?
