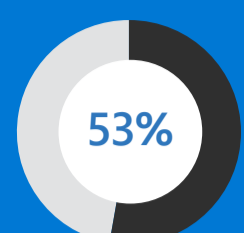
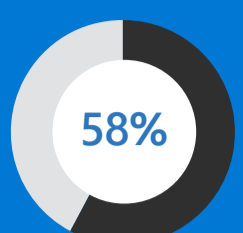

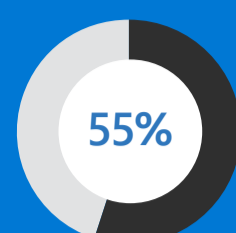
53% of small and medium size businesses handle sensitive information such as social security numbers.¹

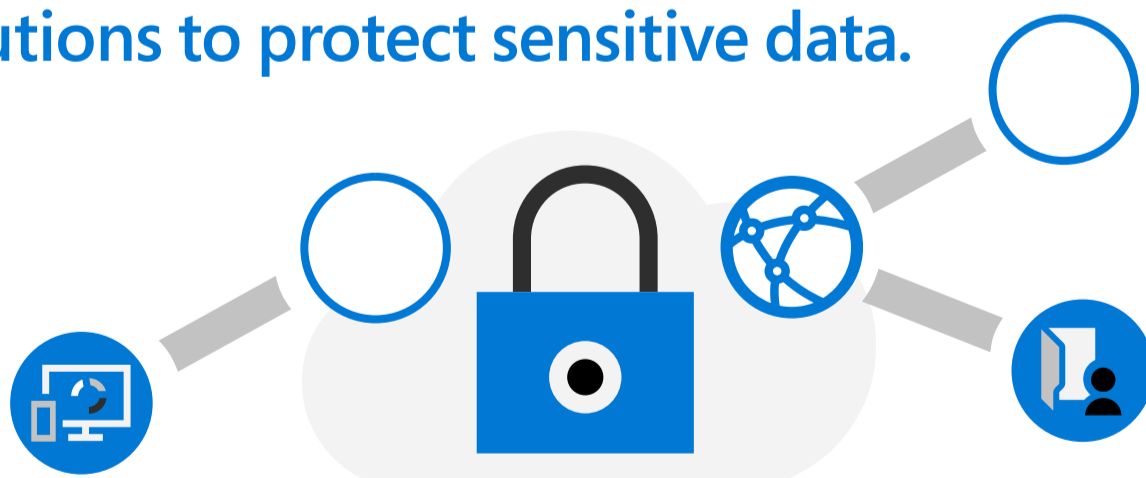
